THE MARYLAND SPCA HOLDS 15TH ANNUAL MARCH FOR THE ANIMALS

*Pet Lovers and Their Furry Friends March
to Raise Money for Needy Animals*

Baltimore— Over 5,000 animal lovers and their four-legged friends are expected to attend the Maryland SPCA's 15th Annual March for the Animals at Druid Hill Park from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Sunday, April 18, 2010. Participants will be supporting homeless animals in the Baltimore community while getting a little exercise and having lots of fun!

Registration opens at 9 a.m. and starting line ceremonies will take place at 10 a.m. In addition to the 1.5 mile walk-a-thon, the day will include a demonstration by **Mid-Atlantic Disc Dogs, pet training tips, an agility course** for dogs, **low-cost micro-chipping**, a “flea-less” market of pet friendly vendors, musical chairs for dogs, and a **pet costume contest judged by celebrity guests**. Great food and other entertainment will be part of the fun as well.

Prizes will be awarded to the top fundraisers, including a **grand prize trip to the Bahamas**. Participants will receive a special “doggy bag” that includes treats, corporate giveaways and other gifts. Dog bandanas will be given to those who raise at least \$30, and the 2010 March for the Animals t-shirt will be given to walkers who raise at least \$40. The deadline to register a Pack is March 31.

Participants can walk individually or form a “Pack.” Packs get to choose their own unique Pack name, which will be printed on their March for the Animals t-shirts. Packs also get their photo taken at the event and are eligible for a special grand prize for the top fundraising team—the use of the Governor’s Box at Camden Yards for an Orioles game.
