



How to Make a Tissue Kebab Cat Toy

Adapted from Make Your Own Cat Toys: Saving the Planet one Cat Toy at a Time by Holly Tse

Materials

- 1 shoelace
- Cereal or cracker box
- Scraps of tissue paper (at least 2"x2")
- Scissors

Step 1

Tie a double knot at one end of the shoelace.



Step 2

Cut five or six 2" circles out of the box. Be careful there are no sharp edges.



Step 3

Fold circles in half. Make a small cut along the fold.



Step 4

Unfold circle and then fold it again the other way. Make another small cut along the fold. This should make a small "X" in the center of the circle.

Step 5

Thread the shoelace through the "X" and push down until it sits on top of the shoelace knot.



Step 6

Gently poke a hole through one piece of tissue paper and thread the shoelace through it. Repeat until you have about 1" of tissue height. Scrunch the tissue paper a bit to create texture.

Repeat steps 5 and 6 until you have used all of the circles.
